### **About the Position:**

South Lane Mental Health is seeking a Vocational Specialist for our Assertive Community Treatment program (ACT). A member of the ACT team, the Vocational Specialist will be the point person for work and volunteer goals of clients and provide specialized support and assistance to clients. Full time Qualified Mental Health Associates, ACT team members work to help individuals with severe and persistence mental illness living in the community. Team members build helping relationships with clients, help clients identify personal strengths, resources needed to acquire skills and supports, and assist clients in developing and implementing individuals plans.

### **Position Duties:**

- Provide treatment to ACT clients, with a focus on supporting skill building for vocational goals
- Create individualized Assessments and Individualized Service Plans with program participants
- Facilitate peer support groups
- Document services as appropriate and complete all required paperwork in a timely fashion
- Participate in Quality Assurance completeness and quality reviews as required
- Participate as a member of a treatment team; attend supervisory and training meetings as required
- Provide crisis services as required
- Meet any job requirements regarding productivity and dependability
- Positively represent South Lane Mental Health in the community and with other service providers
- As required, act as a liaison with other organizations
- Provide after-hours crisis and pager response services and work a flexible schedule

### **Position Requirements:**

- Ability to be designated as a Qualified Mental Health Associate in Lane County (Bachelor's Degree in behavioral sciences field or at least three years relevant experience)
- Experience with Integrated Supported Employment programs preferred
- Verification of past employment and education
- Experience in dual diagnosis treatment

- Have experience identifying stages of change and developing strategic interventions
- Ability to communicate effectively
- Understand mental health assessment, treatment and service terminology and apply each of these concepts
